He obtained the FEBO Diploma as Examiner of the European Board of Ophthalmology and was a member of the Board of the Hellenic Ophthalmological Society for six years. In 2013 he has been elected as the President of the Greek Glaucoma Society for the next four years. He was member of the organizing Committees of 3 Panhellenic Ophthalmological Congresses and 14 International Glaucoma Congresses in Athens.
